


ATHENS

(Advanced Technologies in Higher Education Network/Socrates)



- 15 EU partner universities
- 1-week intensive course 2x a year (March, Nov.)
- 1 credit/course
- Course is free, travel and accommodation costs have to be paid individually
- During studies it is possible to apply for this several times
- Next course: 15-22 November, 2025
- Application deadline: 24 September, 2025

Pan-European Seal (PES) Program



- Professional, paid traineeship program at EU bodies
- Who can apply? Final year BSc, MSc, or graduated MSc students, PhD students
- Location of the traineeship

PES Program

- Duration: 12 months
- 3 pilars: traineeship course with professional mentors
 - ✓ online language courses and other study programs (eg. carrier-counselling),
 - Professional language courses
- Application procedure:
- ➤ 1. BME application until **16.02. 2026**
- 2. winners are nominated to the bodies and they need to apply individually
- BME has 10 spots/ academic year
- Scholarship: EPO: 2000 EUR/month, EUIPO: 1300 EUR/months



Erasmus +Study Mobility (SMS) for 2026-2027

- **■** More than 400 EU and outside of EU University
- Application period: November December
- 2 active semesters are completed
- minimum B2 language exam is required.
- Duration: minimum 2 months upto 12 months/ study level
- Active student status:

OBLIGATORY during the mobility

Student Mobility for Traineeships (SMT)

- Traineeships to gain international experience all over the world
- Host company/ laboratory find individually
- Duration: min 2 months max 12 months
- Available on all study levels
- Two types:
- 1. During studies must have active student status
- 2. After graduation within one year of the graduation Call for applications: https://nki.bme.hu/SZAKGYAK

Erasmus BIP, Blended

There are also opportunities for short-term mobilities (5–30 days).

These are blended programmes, where the physical component is complemented by a virtual part.

In both cases, there must be a bilateral agreement with the partner institution.

Two types:

- 1. BIP (Blended Intensive Programme):
- -The mobility may be organised by the Faculty (in this case it is group-based), but it can also be arranged individually.
- -Individual application is simple: https://nki.bme.hu/ERASMUS%20BIP%20for%20Students
- -It is important to provide the BIP ID.
- 2. Blended
- Individual application.

TWO TYPES OF ADDITIONAL SUPPORT GRANTS for:

- I. Students facing social, cultural, societal, economic, or geographical barriers
 - grant: 250 EUR/month
- II. Students with health conditions (disabilities or long-term illnesses)
 - grant: 250 EUR/month (in case of submitting ONLY type II. Application) or
 - grant: individually calculated additional total cost for the entire mobility period (in case of submitting both Type I. and II. Applications)



CEEPUS - CENTRAL EUROPEAN EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR UNIVERSITY STUDIES

CEEPUS Member Countries: Albania, Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, North Macedonia, Moldavia, Montenegro, Poland, Prishtina/Kosovo, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, the Czech Republic and Hungary

CEEPUS application via Network-Based Application or as Freemover

Fee-paying students: You can apply for study period (3-5 months), research related to the thesis/dissertation (1-2 months)

SH students are eligible to apply for a max. 30-day long CEEPUS scholarship

Online application process - www.ceepus.info

Network-Based Application: registration and filling in the application form on the central website. No documents required.

Freemover mobility: + uploading documents: letter of acceptance issued by the host institution, 2 letters of recommendation issued by lecturers of your home institution

Eligibility criteria: enrolled student status at BME during the mobility period, 2 completed semesters until the mobility period and nomination from both the BME and host institutions' network coordinator, in the case of network mobility.

Scholarship rates: the amount is different in every country. + travel and additionnal support for students with fewer opportunities

Submission deadline:

Network: Winter semester: 15 June

Summer semester: 31 October

Freemover mobility applications: 1 July – 30 November
