ABOUT THE PROJECT:

This is a youth exchange through which we aim to create an opportunity for young people to raise their motivation and develop a positive attitude towards environmental protection, developing the skills in responsible civic involvement, organizing and conducting volunteer activities for environmental protection and for the development of their community, to increase the level of information and awareness among members of partner communities.

By using non-formal education methods, the participants will learn more about the Erasmus + program and the Youthpass certificate, learn together about volunteering and civic involvement, their role in local decision-making, information and greening campaigns, and find ways to capitalize on recycled materials in decorative spaces that change the attitude of citizens towards the environment.

RESULTS OF THE PROJECT:

- 40 motivated young exchange participants, with a civic and creative spirit developed for volunteer activities in environmental protection,
- 3 marked tourist routes (religious, historical, ecological),
- 3 maps with marked tourist routes,
- 4 partner communities with a high degree of awareness of the need to protect the environment,
- and an e-Guide of good volunteering practices for environment protection.



PARTICIPANTS' PROFILE:

- 10 young people/group, aged between 16 and 22
- coming from rural areas
- 2 group leaders/group
- from Hungary, Croatia, Serbia and Romania.

In this youth exchange there will be 48 people involved in total..

ACCOMMODATION: LOCATION AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

TRAVEL

As the venue, Milcoveni is a small village in the countryside, we are going to provide pick-ups from your arrival venue to the camp.

WHERE TO ARRIVE?

- In Timisoara:
 - by plane: Traian Vuia International Airport
 - by train: Timisoara Nord Railway station
 - by bus: Timisoara Normanida Bus Station
- In Belgrade:
 - The pick-up point is in the blue locomotive near the central train station
- In Milcoveni:
 - by private transport company



Before purchasing your tickets, please connect the sending organisation and wait for their confirmation!

COSTS:

Accommodation, food and materials during activity days are fully covered by the project.

TRAVEL GRANT:

Please have in mind, if we provide transfers between the arrival point and the venue, we will take the following amount from the above mentioned grants:

- Belgrade: 60€/participant/return
- Timisoara 30€/participant/return



TRAVEL COST REIMBURSEMENT

Keep all the documents related to your travel - both, the paper-based and digital copies!

- Invoices,
 - e-tickets / confirmation email of the journey
 - boarding passes,
 - bus/train tickets,
 - petrol station receipts etc.
- + bank statement/card transactions as proof of payment



In order to do the reimbursement, we are going to need all these documents, and we are going to collect them during the youth exchange.

USEFUL INFORMATION



WEATHER

During mid-September, the weather is expected to be warmer, but can be changable, and chilly in the nights. In any case, check the weather forecast before your arrival and prepare your luggage accordingly.

CURRENCY

In Romania the currency is RON, we do not use Euro. The exchange rate is around 1 EUR= 4.90 RON.

Have in mind to take some cash with you, because there is no exchange points in the village, and bank cards are not accepted in the shops.

HEALTH INSURANCE

To have EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) or other type of health insurance is mandatory for all participants.


LET'S TALK ABOUT THE COVID SITUATION...



As we are going to be in a small village, and only our group will be hosted, the connection with other people outside the group will be minimalized. However, due to the Covid-19 situation, will be issued a set of rules for preventive measures, the participants will be informed about restrictions, rules and regulations in Romania.

The participants will get masks and hand sanitizers each day.

Eventual expenditure for the COVID test (specifically the PCR), which can be asked to travel between countries (generally by airplane) can be included in the travel budget but cannot go over the maximum reimbursement for the Travel costs established according to the Erasmus+ rules.
