<b>Qualification</b>	Currently-enrolled student at one of Inha University's partner institutions Bachelor's degree holder <b>*Applicants must contact professors of their chosen department or laboratory first by email and have an approval before applying.</b>
<b>GPA</b>	a minimum 2.5 out of 4.5 cumulative GPA (2.22 out of 4.0) or 75 out of 100 points equivalent at home institution
<b>Proof of language</b>	<b>All applicants must meet one of the following conditions:</b> a) Obtain official English proficiency test score(minimum score of TOEFL iBT 71, IELTS 5.5, Duolingo English Test 90) b) Submit a recommendation letter by your faculty which ensures your English fluency if you do not have a valid English proficiency test score as stated in section (a) above <b>※ Applicants who will apply to below departments to study in Korean Language must submit TOPIK.</b> <u><b>For master level applicant, TOPIK 4 or above, for Ph.D applicant, TOPIK 5 or above.</b></u> <b>Korean Language Education</b> <b>Korean Language &amp; Literature</b>
<b>Etc</b>	<b>School of Medicine does not accept exchange students.</b> <b>Please be noted that all departments in Humanities and most of Social sciences hardly have lectures conducted in English.</b>
