Objectives and Description	<p>Students can choose between two programs alternatively:</p> <p>Program 1: Italian language courses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A1 level: This level is for those who have never attended an Italian language course. The main aim of the course is to help the student understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to the most immediately relevant areas (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping).- A2 level: This level is for those who have attended an Italian language course for a short period of time. The main aim of the course is to help the student understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to the most immediately relevant areas (e.g. Shopping, Local geography, Transport, Travel, Holidays and Hotels, Employment); <p>Program 2: Workshops and seminars on Language testing for Italian as a second language (for students who already have a B1-B2 level of knowledge of the Italian language).</p> <p>Optional cultural visits are planned in the province of Pescara.</p>
Methods and outcomes	1) Students will learn and use strategies for studying various aspects of the Italian language (e.g. vocabulary, grammar, comprehension and production); they also will
